Norfolk International Airport reports on November 2019 activity - CORRECTED

NORFOLK, **Va. – (December 11, 2019)** – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 1.38 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of November 2019 with 320,154 total passengers. This figure compares to a November 2018 passenger count of 324,646. January to November 2019 total passenger count has increased 8.90 percent representing 3,641,871 passengers versus 3,340,260 passengers during the same period in 2018.

In other activity, 5,063,210 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during November 2019. This represents a 7.53 percent decrease versus November 2018, which saw 5,475,273 pounds of cargo shipped. January to November 2019 cargo pounds shipped have decreased 1.03 percent representing 58,564,152 cargo pounds versus 59,176,008 cargo pounds during the same period in 2018.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by scheduled airlines Allegiant, American, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, United and their regional airline partners and charter airlines Miami Air, Sun Country, Swift Air and XTRAirways. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

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Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Coastal Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with scheduled air service provided by Allegiant, American, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, United and their affiliate airline partners. Together they provide nonstop access to 29 major airports (includes year-round and seasonal service), most of which are international gateways, allowing convenient access to global destinations. According to the FAA, Norfolk International Airport's passenger activity is ranked in the top 13% of commercial service airports in the United States with over 3.6 million scheduled passengers served in 2018.
