Norfolk International Airport Reports on June 2024 Activity

NORFOLK, Va. - (July 12, 2024) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported an 11.4 percent increase for June with 481,441 passengers served, the busiest month in the airport's history. This figure compares to a June 2023 passenger count of 432,126. ORF's total over the first six months of 2024 increased 10.2 percent representing 2,296,938 passengers compared to 2,084,108 passengers during the same period last year.

In other activity, 4,087,224 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport last month, a 22 percent decrease compared to 5,241,337 pounds of cargo shipped in June 2023. From January to June, cargo pounds shipped through ORF decreased 22.1 percent representing 23,516,860 cargo pounds versus 30,188,094 cargo pounds during the first six months of the prior year.

The above-mentioned figures reflect service by scheduled airlines Allegiant, American, Breeze, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, Spirit and United, as well as charter airlines. All-cargo carriers include Federal Express and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport is the major airport serving coastal Virginia and northeast North Carolina, ranking in the top 13 percent of U.S. airports with more than 4.5 million passengers and 75,000 flight operations in 2023. Skytrax has awarded Norfolk Airport a <u>4-Star Regional Airport</u> rating. Among 572 airports rated in the 2023 survey, Norfolk Airport is one of just seven 4-Star airports in the United States. Skytrax annual ratings are known as a global benchmark of airport standards.
